



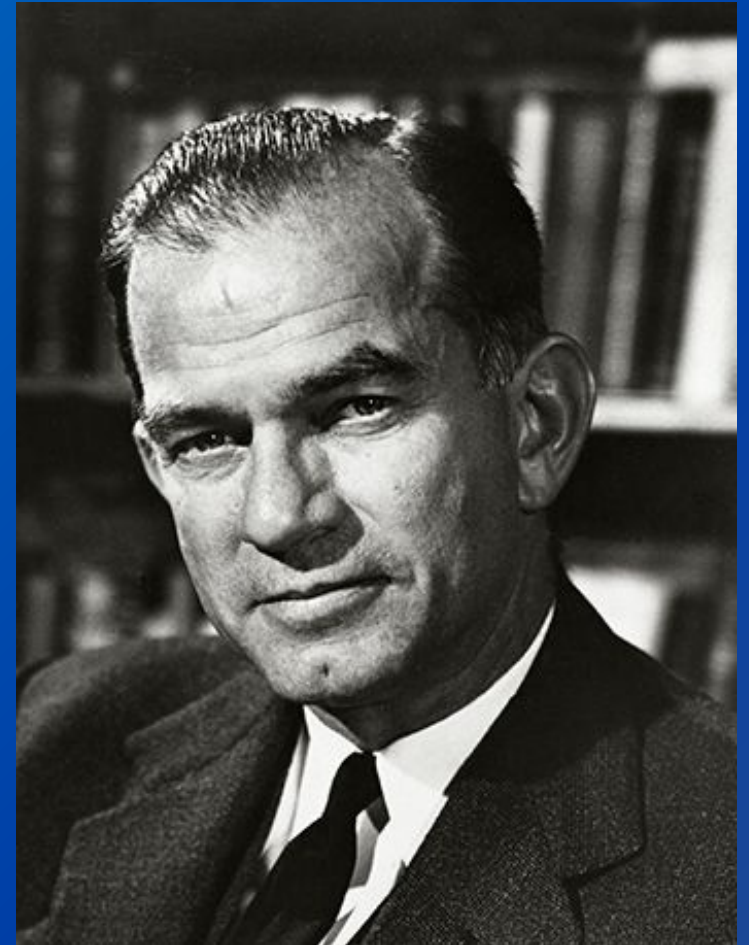

THE FULBRIGHT PROGRAM

- Established in 1946 by U.S. Congress.
- Fulbright is the United States government's flagship international educational and cultural exchange program offering opportunities for students and young professionals to undertake international graduate study, advanced research, university teaching, and primary/secondary school teaching worldwide.
- **The Fulbright Program** operates in over 160 countries worldwide with 49 bi-national commissions.

After World War II, he thought of an international exchange program to “pick up the pieces” and create a more peaceful and prosperous future for all nations.

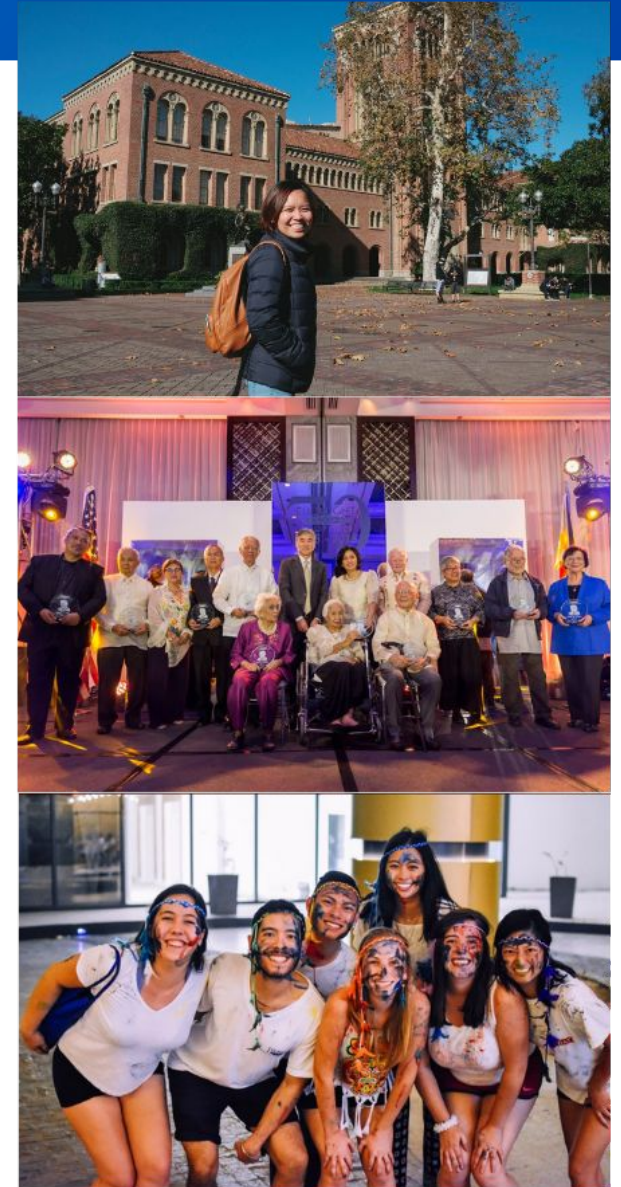


Since its inception in 1946, nearly 400,000 Fulbrighters have participated from over 160 countries.

The Program awards approximately 8,000 fellowships annually.

FULBRIGHT PHILIPPINES

- Established through a bi-national agreement by the United States and Philippine governments in 1948.
- The oldest continuing Fulbright commission in the world, and international educational scholarship in the Philippines.
- Has funded nearly 3,000 Filipinos and 1,000 U.S. scholars.
- Alumni include government and business leaders, national artists, national scientists, and recognized experts in their field.

FULBRIGHT FOREIGN STUDENT PROGRAM

brings graduate students, early career professionals and artists from the Philippines to pursue graduate studies (Master's or Doctoral) or dissertation research in the United States.



FULBRIGHT-CHED SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

enables qualified higher education faculty and staff currently affiliated with CHED-recognized higher education institutions, to pursue doctoral studies in the United States to upgrade the country's higher education system.



FULBRIGHT ADVANCED RESEARCH AND UNIVERSITY LECTURING PROGRAM

brings Filipino academics
and professionals to
lecture and/or conduct
research in the United



FULBRIGHT U.S.-ASEAN VISITING SCHOLAR PROGRAM

Is open to university faculty, foreign

research on issues relevant to member



HUBERT H. HUMPHREY FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM

brings mid-career professionals for a
year of combined non-graduate study
and related practical & professional
experience in the United States.



FULBRIGHT FOREIGN LANGUAGE TEACHING ASSISTANT (FLTA) PROGRAM

aims to strengthen foreign language instruction at U.S. educational institutions by establishing a native speaker presence. Filipino English teachers living outside Metro Manila are given the opportunities to enhance their opportunities to enhance their competencies and knowledge in teaching English as a foreign language.

FULBRIGHT DISTINGUISHED AWARDS IN TEACHING PROGRAM FOR INTERNATIONAL TEACHERS (FULBRIGHT DAI)

provides high school teachers and staff with a unique opportunity to develop greater expertise in their subject areas, enhance their teaching skills, increase their knowledge about the United States, and compete in either an individual or group project.



GLOBAL UNDERGRADUATE EXCHANGE PROGRAM (GLOBAL UGRAD)

Provides a diverse group of emerging student leaders with a scholarship of one semester of non-degree academic study at a U.S. college or university. The Global UGRAD program aims to recruit participants from underrepresented, non-elite backgrounds, who have not had other opportunities to study in the United States.

FULBRIGHT STUDENT PROGRAM

is for American students and graduating senior students for research and study in the Philippines. Graduate students are either doctoral candidates who plan to conduct dissertation in the Philippines, or students pursuing master's degree thesis projects.

FULBRIGHT SENIOR SCHOLAR PROGRAM

brings U.S. academics and professionals for lecturing, research, or a combination of lecturing and research projects in the Philippines.

FULBRIGHT SPECIALIST PROGRAM

Is designed to provide short-term academic opportunities for U.S. faculty and professionals. The FSP promotes linkages between U.S. academics and professionals and their counterparts at host institutions overseas.
